2020 ISA Cleveland Section Golf Outing Terms and Conditions

Due to COVID-19, by signing up for this event, you agree to abide by the following guidelines. Players that fail to adhere to the following policies will asked to leave the event and the premises.

- Participants will wear a mask while in the pavilion, clubhouse, or within six feet of another individual.
- No spectators.
- Participants MUST maintain Social Distancing of at least six feet apart at all times. (e.g. No handshakes, high-fives or other forms of touching.)
- Participants shall not remove the flag from the hole. There is an insert in the hole to allow the removal of the ball without touching the flag staff.
- Sand trap or bunker rakes are not available.
- Frequently and thoroughly wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use hand sanitizer when soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
- Touch only your own equipment, including golf balls and tees.
- Wait your turn before stepping up to tee off or putt throughout the course.
- Registration fees are preferred to be prepaid; they will not be accepted at the event. Those not registered will be invoiced after the event.
- There will be no catered dinner. We will be issuing restaurant gift cards to each golfer to be used at their convenience.
- At the end of the outing, if you have won a skill category or place position, your prize will be
 distributed to you even if you are not present as we will be still distributing prizes as usual. This
 will be in the pavilion with participants using every other table, practicing social distancing and
 wearing a mask.

Blackbrook Golf Course Policies

- Shotgun start will be conducted differently. We will not be congregating at the start of the outing. Instead, each cart will go to their designated starting hole and tee off at 9:00 AM.
- If the golfers assigned to the same cart would rather have individual carts, the course will accommodate this request at no charge.
- Lunch will be provided by the course snack bar at the at the turn. Participants must follow
 posted clubhouse rules, including but not limited to wearing a mask and maintaining social
 distancing.
- Beverage carts are prohibited on the course. We will provide a courtesy bag with ice and drinks for each cart at the beginning and at the turn.

- Take your temperature before arriving to the event. Please stay home if your temperature is 100.4 degrees or higher.
- Stay home if feeling unwell, or you experience any COVID-19 related symptoms (fatigue, respiratory, other cold or flu-like symptoms, lack of taste and smell, etc.)
- Any player with noticeable symptoms will be asked to leave the event and the premises.
